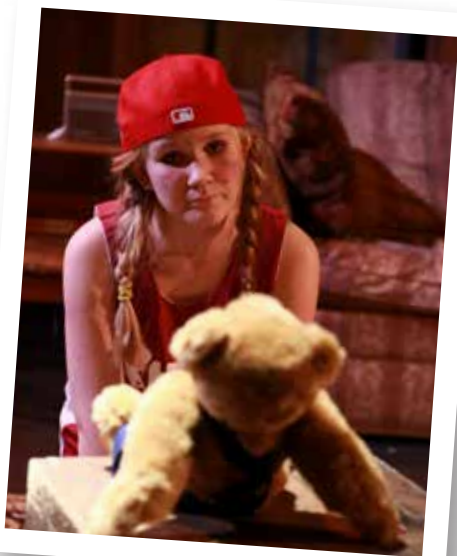

He is the writer and creator of several new plays including THE SCIENCE OF FICTION, RE/FRACTION, AIR HEART and A NIGHTTIME SURVIVAL GUIDE. He has a passion for teaching young performers and has worked as an acting teacher for The Idaho Shakespeare Festival, Eagle Performing Arts Center, College of Idaho, and the Ohio State University. He was also a puppeteer, swordfighter and stilt-walker in Las Vegas. Dwayne has trained with Anne Bogart's SIT1 Company in New York, and specializes in teaching Viewpoints and Suzuki training for actors. Dwayne earned his M.F.A. in acting at the Ohio State University with a focus on movement and devising new work.
